JM: Requested FEMA's definition of "Neighborhood Associations," because we can receive extra points by conducting a presentation on our floodplain initiatives.

JD: We can also make ourselves available at certain community events, such as Irish Festival or Italian Festival. Bring our information to work in conjunction with North Wildwood Office of Emergency Management.

RS: We can also obtain a booth at National Night Out.

RP: Noted that we need to request the Emergency Preparedness Plan from Cape May County if this year is a new year to update (Believed to be updated every 5 years). Ralph also noted that we can utilize 1640AM way more than we actually do.

JD: We should do mail outs of the NW Emergency Preparedness Information. We can also drop off copies to realtors, insurance agencies and banks. School presentations can also be held at: MMS, CTC, WC.
