Rules for Vehicles Operating on the Beach

For the Purpose of Sport Fishing

2016-2017

The City of North Wildwood in accordance with the municipal code (chapter 138 section 6) permits vehicles to be operated on the beach during the period from **September 6, 2016** through **May 25, 2017**, for the purpose of sport fishing only.

<u>May 1st through the Monday before Memorial Day</u> ½ hour before sunrise until 10:00 a.m. and from 4:00 p.m. until ½ hour after sunset.	<u>May 1st to May 25th, 2017</u> 9am to 6pm – JFK to New York Avenue (Inlet Beach) OPEN 9am to 6pm - JFK to 26 th Avenue Beaches CLOSED Between 6am to 9am & 6pm to 10pm – entire beach OPEN to permitted vehicles
<u>USE APPROPRIATE BEACH ENTRANCE DURING HOURS THAT THE ADJACENT BEACH IS OPEN</u> 2ND & Ocean Avenues, 5th & JFK or 15th & Beach Entrance Vehicles must cross over the dunes at the specific vehicle crossovers located at 5 th , 15 th and 22 nd Avenue Use of a pedestrian crossover by a vehicle is strictly prohibited	

The applicant must present the vehicle that the permit will be issued on at the North Wildwood Police Department for inspection. The applicant must then complete an application and submit the appropriate fee. The vehicle must contain certain items before use on the beach. Upon meeting this requirement a permit sticker will be issued.

RULES:

Permit fees: \$20.00.

Required equipment: tow rope, jack with board, inflated spare tire, shovel, fire extinguisher with the necessary material and supplies, first aid kit and flashlight.

Prohibited vehicles: no vehicles with eating or sleeping accommodations shall be issued a permit or to be operated on the beaches at any time.

Vehicle Requirements: the vehicle must be properly registered and bear a current inspection sticker issued by the state the vehicle is registered in.

Speed limits: the speed limit for vehicles operated on the beach is 15 mph.

Points of access to the beach: Access to and from the beach shall be made at 2nd Avenue, 5th Avenue and 15th Avenue.

Areas of operation: except during actual entrance and exit from the beach no vehicle shall be operated at a distance of 50 feet from the then existing high tide line and no closer than 50 feet to any sand dune. In addition, while entering and exiting the beach, care shall be taken not to operate across or cause damage to any sand dune.
