We are writing to inform you that we will be placing a small number of new utility poles throughout the City of North Wildwood. The utility poles will house limited, fully concealed telecommunications equipment as well as certain municipal services, enhancing your connectivity and the City's ability to efficiently manage the public Right-of-Way.

These poles will reduce blight and proliferation by hosting multiple occupants per structure in lieu of the wireless carrier alternate - multiple single-use, single-occupant structures. You are receiving this letter because a new utility pole is being installed within 200' of your home. The poles have no external telecom features and blend into the landscape. Each fixture takes about 24-48 hours to complete installation. We appreciate the opportunity to work with your community!

#### **ORDINANCE NO. 1864**

#### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1177, AS AMENDED

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of North Wildwood, in the County of Cape May and State of New Jersey as follows:

**Section One.** The portion of Ordinance 1177, as amended, that has been codified in the Code of the City of North Wildwood at §276-23A is hereby amended to the extent that §276-23A shall henceforth read as follows:

A. Purpose statement. The purpose of the Dining and Entertainment (D & E) Zoning District is to revitalize the City's historic "Tavern District" by providing for a critical mass of restaurant, nightlife and such other entertainment-oriented amenities as are customary to such a district.

**Section Two.** The portion of Ordinance 1177, as amended, that has been codified in the Code of the City of North Wildwood at §276-23B(10) is hereby repealed.

**Section Three.** §276-23B(10) is hereby designated as (Reserved) for future use.

**Section Four.** If any portion of this Ordinance is determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, that determination shall have no effect upon the remainder of this Ordinance, which shall remain valid and operable.

<u>Section Five.</u> All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance, to the extent of such inconsistencies only, be and the same hereby are repealed.

<u>Section Six.</u> This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as provided by law.

BOND ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF CERTAIN FIRE APPARATUS FOR THE CITY OF NORTH WILDWOOD, IN THE COUNTY OF CAPE MAY, NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$560,000 THEREFOR; **AUTHORIZING** THE **ISSUANCE BOND GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS** OR ANTICIPATION NOTES OF THE CITY OF NORTH WILDWOOD, IN THE COUNTY OF CAPE MAY, NEW JERSEY, IN THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF UP TO \$532,000; MAKING CERTAIN DETERMINATIONS AND COVENANTS; AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN RELATED ACTIONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE **FOREGOING** 

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of North Wildwood, in the County of Cape May, New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), pursuant to the provisions of the Local Bond Law, constituting Chapter 169 of the Laws of 1960 of the State of New Jersey, as amended and supplemented ("Local Bond Law"), as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> The purposes described in Section 7 hereof are hereby authorized as general improvements to be made or acquired by City of North Wildwood, in the County of Cape May, New Jersey ("City").

#### **Section 2.** It is hereby found, determined and declared as follows:

- (a) the estimated amount to be raised by the City from all sources for the purposes stated in Section 7 hereof is \$560,000;
- (b) the estimated amount of bonds or bond anticipation notes to be issued for the purposes stated in Section 7 hereof is \$532,000; and
- (c) a down payment in the amount of \$28,000 for the purposes stated in Section 7 hereof is currently available in accordance with the requirements of Section 11 of the Local Bond Law, *N.J.S.A.* 40A:2-11.

- The sum of \$532,000, to be raised by the issuance of bonds or bond anticipation notes, together with the sum of \$28,000, which amount represents the required down payment, are hereby appropriated for the purposes stated in this bond ordinance ("Bond Ordinance").
- The issuance of negotiable bonds of the City in an amount not to exceed Section 4. \$532,000 to finance the costs of the purposes described in Section 7 hereof is hereby authorized. Said bonds shall be sold in accordance with the requirements of the Local Bond Law.
- In order to temporarily finance the purposes described in Section 7 hereof, the issuance of bond anticipation notes of the City in an amount not to exceed \$532,000 is hereby authorized. Pursuant to the Local Bond Law, the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to sell part or all of the bond anticipation notes from time to time at public or private sale and to deliver the same to the purchasers thereof upon receipt of payment of the purchase price plus accrued interest from their date to delivery thereof. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby directed to report in writing to the governing body at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of the bond anticipation notes pursuant to this Bond Ordinance is made. Such report must include the amount, the description, the interest rate and the maturity schedule of the bond anticipation notes sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.
- Section 6. The amount of the proceeds of the obligations authorized by this Bond Ordinance which may be used for the payment of interest on such obligations, accounting, engineering, legal fees and other items as provided in Section 20 of the Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20, shall not exceed the sum of \$112,000.
- The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which said Section 7. obligations are to be issued; the estimated costs of each said purpose; the amount of down payment for each said purpose; the maximum amount obligations to be issued for each said purpose and the period of usefulness of each said purpose within the limitations of the Local Bond Law are as follows:

Section 9. The supplemental debt statement provided for in Section 10 of the Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-10, was duly filed in the office of the Clerk prior to the passage of this Bond Ordinance on first reading and a complete executed duplicate original thereof has been filed in the Office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey. The supplemental debt statement shows that the gross debt of the City, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-43, is increased by this Bond Ordinance by \$532,000 and that the obligations authorized by this Bond Ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

- Section 10. The full faith and credit of the City are irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on the bonds or bond anticipation notes authorized by this Bond Ordinance, and to the extent payment is not otherwise provided, the City shall levy <u>ad valorem</u> taxes on all taxable real property without limitation as to rate or amount for the payment thereof.
- <u>Section 11.</u> The applicable Capital Budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Bond Ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith, and the resolution promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended Capital Budget and Capital Program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Clerk and available for inspection.
- Section 12. The City hereby declares its intent to reimburse itself from the proceeds of the bonds or bond anticipation notes authorized by this Bond Ordinance pursuant to Income Tax Regulation Section 1.150-2(e), promulgated under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended ("Code"), for "original expenditures", as defined in Income Tax Regulation Section 1.150-2(c)(2), made by the City prior to the issuance of such bonds or bond anticipation notes.

#### **Section 13.** The City hereby covenants as follows:

- (a) it shall take all actions necessary to ensure that the interest paid on the bonds or bond anticipation notes authorized by this Bond Ordinance is exempt from the gross income of the owners thereof for federal income taxation purposes, and will not become a specific item of tax preference pursuant to Section 57(a)(5) of the Code;
- (b) it will not make any use of the proceeds of the bonds or bond anticipation notes or do or suffer any other action that would cause the bonds or bond anticipation notes to be "arbitrage bonds" as such term is defined in Section 148(a) of the Code and the Regulations promulgated thereunder;
- (c) it shall calculate or cause to be calculated and pay, when due, the rebatable arbitrage with respect to the "gross proceeds" (as such term is used in Section 148(f) of the Code) of the bonds or bond anticipation notes;
- (d) it shall timely file with the Internal Revenue Service, such information report or reports as may be required by Sections 148(f) and 149(e) of the Code; and
- (e) it shall take no action that would cause the bonds or bond anticipation notes to be "federally guaranteed" within the meaning of Section 149(b) of the Code.

- <u>Section 14.</u> The improvements authorized hereby are not current expenses and are improvements that the City may lawfully make. No part of the cost of the improvements authorized hereby has been or shall be specially assessed on any property specially benefited thereby.
- **Section 15.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.
- <u>Section 16.</u> In accordance with the Local Bond Law, this Bond Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

# CITY OF NORTH WILDWOOD CALENDAR YEAR 2022 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)

#### **ORDINANCE NO. 1869**

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of North Wildwood in the County of Cape May finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2022 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the City of North Wildwood hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$713,156.94 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of North Wildwood hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated, as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the City of North Wildwood, in the County of Cape May a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2022 budget year, the final appropriations of the City of North Wildwood shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5 %, amounting to \$ 713,156.94 and that the CY 2022 municipal budget for the City of North Wildwood be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

- (A) Professional services of the type herein sought are of such a nature as to require a high degree of trust or confidence in the individual providing the service and, in fact, may require the creation of a confidential or fiduciary relationship between that individual and the municipality;
  - (B) The services required are highly specialized or technical in nature;
- (C) The services require peculiar ability or skill, and demand a high degree of specialized knowledge or expertise;
- (D) The services are such that their relative worth must be judged by subjective considerations that are not susceptible of valuation by competitive bidding;
- (E) The individual or entity who will provide these services has demonstrated competence and particular expertise in the services required;
- (F) The individual or entity who will perform these services is held to and fully adheres to, the strict ethical standards that govern the involved profession;
- (G) The services include advice to and consultation with the municipality that require both knowledge and judgment on the part of the individual or entity providing services, as well as the confidence of the municipal officials, such that competitive bidding is not feasible or practical;
- (H) The services to be provided are such that their nature, scope and duration are not capable of precise measurement, but rather require a flexibility and discretion that render competitive bidding impractical and inefficient; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor has forwarded to City Council his appointment of Nicole Curio, Esquire of the firm of Blaney, Donohue & Weinberg, P.C. for Labor Counsel – Collective Bargaining services for the remainder of the year 2022.

# AWARDING LICENSE FOR SUPPLY, INSTALLATION AND SERVICING OF VENDING MACHINES

**WHEREAS**, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, *et. seq.*, indicates that competitive contracting, in lieu of public bidding, may be used in certain specified cases when the price of the goods and services to be procured exceeds the bid threshold (See N.J.S.A. 40A-11-4.1); and

WHEREAS, two of the instances when competitive contracting may be used are for the procurement of contracted food services and for concessions (See N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.1g and 4.1j); and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law provides that the competitive contracting process is to utilize request for proposal documentation in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.4; and

WHEREAS, the City's existing license for the supply, installation and serving of vending machines upon public property at various locations within the City has, or is about to, come to an end; and

WHEREAS, the competitive contracting process described above can be used for a new vending machine license agreement and, as a result, Council authorized City Clerk to advertise a Request for Qualifications and Proposals ("RFP") for the supply, installation and servicing of vending machines; and

WHEREAS, the advertised date for RFP receipt was February 23, 2022; and

#### AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO LEASE AGREEMENT FOR MUNICIPALLY-OWNED OFFICE SPACE TO THE BOARDWALK SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT MANAGEMENT CORPORATION

**WHEREAS**, the City of North Wildwood is the owner of a building located at 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue and the Boardwalk which, on the first floor, houses public restrooms and which, on the second floor, houses office space that is not needed for use by the City of North Wildwood; and

WHEREAS, the Boardwalk Special Improvement District Management Corporation is the lessee of said building under a lease authorized by Ordinance No. 1630, adopted June 5, 2013, with a corresponding Lease Agreement executed on September 17, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Paragraph 7 of said Lease Agreement states that "the tenant may only use the premises in the following manner and for the following purposes: Administrative office space in connection with its function as the district management corporation for the Boardwalk Special Improvement District;" and

WHEREAS, Paragraph 26 of said Lease Agreement states that "this lease may not be sold, assigned, transferred or sublet without the prior written consent of the landlord. Consent by the landlord to an assignment of this lease shall not, in any way, release the tenant from the conditions, covenants and agreements herein undertaken to be done by the tenant, but such duty to perform shall continue as though such assignment had not been made;" and

WHEREAS, the Boardwalk Special Improvement District Management Corporation has requested that the City of North Wildwood amend said Lease Agreement to allow the top floor office space of said building to be sublet; and

WHEREAS, the Local Lands and Buildings Law, under N.J.S.A. 40A:12-15(c), authorizes municipalities to lease capital improvements to a nonprofit corporation for a "public purpose" which, under N.J.S.A. 40A:12-15(i), includes "any activity for the promotion of the health, safety, morals and general welfare of the community of any nonprofit corporation or association," and, such being the case, the subletting of said office space would only be permitted to a qualified member business of the Boardwalk Special Improvement District.

- 1) All of the statements of the preamble are incorporated herein by this reference thereto as though the same were set forth at length.
- 2) This resolution shall be annexed to and made part of the Lease Agreement executed September 17, 2013 between the City of North Wildwood and the Boardwalk Special Improvement District Management Corporation.
- 3) Paragraph 7 of said Lease Agreement is hereby amended so as to read: "The tenant may only use the premises in the following manner and for the following purposes: Administrative office space in connection with its function as the district management corporation for the Boardwalk Special Improvement District or as office or storage space by a qualified member business of said District."
- 4) Paragraph 26 of said Lease Agreement is hereby amended so as to read: "This lessee is permitted to sublet office space to a qualified member business of the Boardwalk Special Improvement District. Consent by the landlord to a sublet of this lease shall not, in any way, release the tenant from the conditions, covenants and agreements herein undertaken to be done by the tenant, but such duty to perform shall continue as though such sublet had not been made."
- 5) The office space is within a building that was constructed with funds provided by the Boardwalk Special Improvement District ("SID") under a continuing agreement with the City of North Wildwood that the building would be put to use for the purposes and benefit of the member businesses of the SID and the efforts of the SID on behalf of its members and the public at large; as such, funds derived from the lease of said office space shall be paid directly to the SID.

- 6) The term of any proposed lease for said office space shall not extend past December 31, 2032.
- 7) No modification of said office space which would require a Construction Permit and/or Zoning Permit is permitted without prior written consent of the landlord.
- 8) Said office space may only be used as an annex location in support of a qualified member business of the SID as office and storage space and shall not be used as a public retail or wholesale location and may not be used as a business or commercial location where the members of the public are invited in general, though discreet and limited entry by business invitees of the SID Member Business holding the lease is acceptable.
- 9) The lease of said office space shall be awarded through a bid process open to qualified member businesses of the SID.
- 10) The award of a lease agreement for said office space shall be subject to approval by the City of North Wildwood and said approval shall be effectuated by adoption of a resolution by City Council.

**WHEREAS**, the North Wildwood Construction Official and the Avalon Construction Official have agreed to an arrangement wherein the North Wildwood Construction Official would handle any conflict cases which arise pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:23-4.5(j); and

WHEREAS, the City of North Wildwood and the Borough of Avalon have reached an agreement concerning the remuneration to be paid to the City of North Wildwood for performing such conflict services.

- 1) All of the statements of the preamble are incorporated herein by this reference thereto as though the same were set forth at length.
- 2) N.J.A.C. 5:23-4.5(j) shall be annexed to and made part of this Resolution.
- 3) The North Wildwood Construction Official shall not be involved in preliminary procedures of the Borough of Avalon, including, but not limited to, Zoning Permit issuance and verification of Floodplain Protection Ordinance compliance.
- 4) After said preliminary procedures, Construction Plans shall be forwarded to the North Wildwood Construction Official for UCC plan review and permit issuance or denial.
- 5) The North Wildwood Construction Official shall be responsible for conducting all inspections required during construction and the issuance of the Certificate of Occupancy upon completion of the construction.
- 6) The Borough of Avalon enforcing agencies will retain jurisdiction for all on-site inspections pertaining to zoning issues and zoning enforcement both during and post construction, including any inspections required or authorized by Chapter 19 and Chapter 27 of the Avalon Borough Code.
- 7) The Borough of Avalon Division of Code Enforcement shall also retain jurisdiction to monitor all construction sites under Chapter 20 of the Avalon Borough Code for compliance therewith and to issue Orders, including Stop Work Orders as appropriate.
- 8) In consideration of performing those services under the UCC as described herein, the Borough of Avalon will pay over to the City of North Wildwood the entire fee that would otherwise be payable to Avalon under Chapter 20 of the Avalon Borough Code establishing fees and charges for construction permits.
- 9) This Resolution shall take effect immediately and shall be applicable to any pending conflict matter. It shall remain in effect until rescinded by either municipality provided that a minimum of 30 days' advance notice of termination shall be provided to the other municipality.
- 10) A certified copy of this Resolution, having been approved by the Governing Bodies of North Wildwood and Avalon, when signed by the Mayors and Construction Officials of the City of North Wildwood and the Borough of Avalon, and attested by the respective Municipal Clerks, shall constitute the agreement between both municipalities without the need for a more formal agreement. It is understood and agreed that this arrangement is to cover conflict cases only and, as such, does not constitute a Shared Services Agreement but simply an arrangement required by the provisions of N.J.A.C. 5:23-4.5(j).

#### (j) Conflict of interest:

- 1. No person employed by an enforcing agency as a construction or subcode official or as an inspector shall knowingly carry out any inspection or enforcement procedure with respect to any property or business in which he or she, or any close relative or household member, or his or her superior within the enforcing agency, or any close relative or household member of such superior, or any other public official or employee having any direct or indirect control over the funding or operations of the enforcing agency, or any household member of any such public official or employee, has an economic interest. For purposes of this paragraph, "close relative" shall mean and include a spouse, sibling, ancestor or descendant, or the spouse of any of them.
  - i. Where an inspection or enforcement procedure is necessary or required in any such property or business, and there is no other person employed by the enforcing agency who is qualified, pursuant to this chapter, to perform the inspection or enforcement procedure and who is not a subordinate of the person with the direct or indirect economic interest in such property or business, the official or inspector shall arrange for the inspection or enforcement to be carried out either by another local enforcing agency or by the Department.
  - ii. A separate log shall be maintained by the enforcing agency of all inspections and enforcement procedures performed, when permitted in accordance with (j)1i above, with regard to any properties or businesses in which any persons employed by the enforcing agency have a direct or indirect economic interest.
- 2. No person employed by an enforcing agency as a construction or subcode official, assistant to the construction or subcode official, trainee, inspector, or plan reviewer, shall, whether directly or indirectly, be engaged in ownership of, or employment by, or contracting to provide goods or services to, any business furnishing labor, materials, products, or services for the construction, alteration, or demolition of buildings or structures, or for the maintenance of any equipment or building component the maintenance of which is regulated pursuant to this chapter, that is engaged in any such activity within any municipality in which he is so employed by an enforcing agency.
- 3. Persons subject to this subsection shall annually report any income or benefits received from any business or property subject to the Code, or from any business furnishing materials, products, labor or services for types of work subject to the Uniform Construction Code regulations, to the municipal governing body. This report shall include a list of all sources of income, but need not list the amount.
- 4. No person employed by a municipal enforcing agency as a construction official, subcode official or inspector shall be employed to appear before any construction board of appeals, or be involved in any court proceeding within the State, as a paid expert witness, or in any other compensated capacity in any proceeding involving the enforcement of the Uniform Construction Code except on behalf of another enforcing agency, or as a court-appointed witness.
  - i. This prohibition shall not apply to any litigation not involving enforcement of the Code, or to an appearance as a fact witness; nor shall it apply to any activities unrelated to an action for, or an appeal of, enforcement of the Code.
- 5. This section shall not apply to:
  - The ownership of stock or other investment instrument in any corporation listed on any national stock exchange.
  - ii. Any such business or employment outside the State;
  - iii. Dual employment by two or more enforcing agencies;
  - iv. Any business or employment which is not subject to the regulations.
  - v. Service as an instructor in a code enforcement training program.
- 6. Nothing herein shall prohibit a municipality from establishing by ordinance more restrictive provisions covering conflict of interest.

# PROHIBITING MUSIC IN LICENSED AREAS OF TEMPORARY COVID-19 EXPANSION PERMITS AND EXPANDED OUTDOOR DINING AREAS

**WHEREAS**, the expansion of outdoor dining under municipal zoning approval and the creation of temporary COVID-19 expansion permits did not include any provision for the playing of outdoor music; and

**WHEREAS,** P.L.2021, c.15, s.6c specifically allows a municipality to prohibit music in outdoor areas as a condition of zoning approval; and

**WHEREAS,** P.L.2021, c.15, s.6c specifically states that the noise regulations of a municipality shall continue to apply even during the times when outdoor dining and CIVOD-19 permits are in effect; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of North Wildwood is concerned for the peace and good order of the City, its residents and visitors; and

**WHEREAS,** Council deems it prudent and appropriate to implement the provisions of P.L.2021, c.15, s.6c and prohibit music in temporary COVID-19 outdoor dining areas and expansion permit areas until November 30, 2022, at which time outdoor dining regulations and temporary COVID-19 expansion permits expire.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the governing body of the City of North Wildwood, in the County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, that:

- 1. All of the statements of the preamble are repeated and are incorporated herein by this reference thereto as though the same were set forth at length.
- 2. Pursuant to P.L.2021, c.15, s.6c, all musical performances, and the playing or projection of any content from a recording, streaming service or television, cable or internet broadcasting service in outdoor spaces or on public sidewalks are hereby prohibited.
- 3. Said prohibition will be in effect until November 30, 2022, at which time approvals for outdoor dining areas and temporary COVID-19 expansion permits expire.
