# North Wildwood Police Department 2022-2023 RULES & REGULATIONS

## for Operating Vehicles on the Beach for Recreational Purposes

The City of North Wildwood in accordance with the Municipal Code (Chapter 138 Section 6&7) permits vehicles to be operated on the beach during the period from

September 6, 2022 - May 25, 2023 (the day after Labor Day to the Thursday before Memorial Day)

Permit fee: \$20.00

### **Dates & Times Beach access is permitted**

On the Inlet Beach: from New York Avenue to the intersection of John F. Kennedy Beach Drive & 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue. From the day after Labor Day to the Monday before the Monday on which Memorial Day is observed, from 4:00 am until 10:00 pm

On the Front Beach from the intersection of John F. Kennedy Beach Drive & 2nd Avenue to 26th Avenue. From October 1st to April 30th, from 4:00 am until 10:00 pm

On the Front Beach: from the intersection of John F. Kennedy Beach Drive and 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to 26<sup>th</sup> Avenue. From the day after Labor Day to September 30<sup>th</sup>, and from May 1<sup>st</sup> to the Monday before the Monday on which Memorial Day is observed, from 4:00 am until 9:00 am and from 6:00 pm until 10:00 pm

#### **USE APPROPRIATE BEACH ENTRANCE DURING HOURS THAT THE ADJACENT BEACH IS OPEN**

1<sup>st</sup> & Surf Avenue, 2<sup>nd</sup> & Ocean Avenue, or 15<sup>th</sup> & Beach Entrance

Vehicles MUST cross over the dunes at the specific vehicle crossover located at 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue

Use caution when crossing over pedestrian walkways at 1<sup>st</sup> & Surf Aves and 2<sup>nd</sup> & Ocean Aves

- ⇒ Required Equipment in Vehicle: tow rope, jack with board, inflated spare tire, shovel, fire extinguisher with the necessary material and supplies, first aid kit and flashlight
- ⇒ **Prohibited vehicles**: no vehicles or sleeping accommodations shall be issued a permit or to be operated on the beaches at any time
- ⇒ **Vehicle Requirements:** the vehicle must be properly registered and bear a current inspection sticker issued by the state the vehicle is registered in
- ⇒ **Speed limits**: the speed limit for vehicles operated on the beach is 15 mph
- ⇒ Points of access to the beach: Access to and from the beach shall be made at 2<sup>nd</sup>, 1<sup>st</sup>, and 15<sup>th</sup> Aves
- → Areas of operation: except during actual entrance and exit from the beach no vehicle shall be operated at a distance of 50 feet from the then existing high tide line and no closer than 50 feet to any sand dune. In addition, while entering and exiting the beach, care shall be taken not to operate across or cause damage to any sand dune.
