- No dumpsters are permitted on streets during the months of June, July and August
- Drawing must be submitted with the permit application showing location of dumpster/container depicting driveways, intersections and property lines (please use other side for drawing)
- Applicant must be the owner of this property and sign this permit application
- Wood pads required under all wheels/skids (2" thick x 12" wide x48" long). Reflective markers on dumpster are required as per ordinance
- All dumpsters must be covered w/ a tarp or other industry acceptable material at the end of each workday or during any prolonged period of time when not in use

• Fees: 1-day \$50, 7-days \$150, 30-days \$250

- Permitted as temporary storage not exceeding 60-days
- Must be secured during high winds/storms
- Time may be extended with permission from Zoning Officer upon written request
- Not permitted in streets, public rightof-ways or unimproved front yards.
- Container must be on paved/concrete off-street surfaces at furthest accessible point from the street
- Container must comply with accessory structure set-back requirements in the zone in which placement is to occur

217-1 Permits required. Consistent with N.J.S.A. 27:51-1, no person shall park or leave unattended any waste or refuse container, commonly known as a "roll-off dumpster" or "roll-off container," on or along any street, highway or public property within the City of North Wildwood without first obtaining a permit from the City Clerk. Application forms for a permit to place a roll-off dumpster or roll-off container upon a street, highway or public property within the City of North Wildwood shall be obtained from the office of the City Clerk. The application forms for a permit to place a roll-off dumpster or roll-off container upon a street, highway or public property within the City of North Wildwood shall be obtained from the office of the City Clerk. 217-2 Permit time and fees. A. Consistent with N.J.S.A. 27:5I-1, approval for placement of a roll-off dumpster or roll-off container upon a street, highway or public property shall

217-2 Permit time and fees. A. Consistent with N.J.S.A. 27:51-1, approval for placement of a roll-off dumpster or roll-off container upon a street, highway or public property shall remain in effect for a period of not more than 30 days. Prior to expiration of an initial thirty-day approval, a thirty-day permit once may be endorsed for a thirty-day renewal period by the City Clerk without charge to the applicant. No permits or extensions thereof shall be issued which would allow placement of a roll-off dumpster or roll-off container on or along any public street, highway or public property for any portion of the months of June, July or August.
B. Fees: (1) One-day permit: \$50. (2) Seven-day permit: \$150. (3) Thirty-day permit: \$250.
C. Only those permits taken out for a thirty-day period shall be eligible for the additional thirty-day renewal period as outlined in Subsection A of this section. One-day permits and seven-day permits shall not be eligible for any period of renewal.
D. In addition to the prohibition of dumpsters during the months of June, July and August as outlined in § 217-2A, no dumpster shall be placed in any parking space requiring payment of a fee for parking, as identified in § 418-1A, from May 15 through May 31 or from September 1 through September 30.
217-3 Location. The property owner shall make every effort to place the roll-off dumpsters or roll-off containers on private property rather then on streets, highways or public property. In such cases where the only practical location of a roll-off dumpster or roll-off container is to a street, highway or public property owner shall may the gued on timber material having minimum dimensions of not less than two inches thick by 12 inches wide by 48 inches long, so as to provide protection to the surface of the street, highway or public property upon which the roll-off dumpster or roll-off container is to be placed.
217-4 Reflective markers required. Consistent

markers shall have a minimum mounting height of three feet from the bottom of the panels to the surface of the roadway. Any person who controls, whether owned, leased, or operated, a refuse container or dumpster shall ensure that such container or dumpster is covered at all times in such a manner so as to prevent refuse from spilling out or overflowing. Any person who owns, leases or otherwise uses a refuse container or dumpster shall ensure that such container or dumpster does not leak or otherwise discharge liquids, semi-liquids or solids to the municipal separate storm sewer system(s) operated by the City of North Wildwood or by any other public body. 217-10 Exceptions to prohibition. The following shall constitute exceptions to the prohibited conduct that is described in the preceding section: A. Permitted temporary demolition containers. B. Litter receptacles (other than dumpsters or other bulk containers). C. Individual homeowner trash and recycling containers. D. As used in this article, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated: PORTABLE STORAGE CONTAINER A self-storage container that is delivered to and retrieved from a property for long-term off-site or temporary on-site storage. Portable Storage On Demand or PODS[®] is a familiar trade name for such containers. Portable storage containers are containers placed on a property for the purpose of temporarily storing materials, including any container, storage unit, shed-like container or other portable structure used for the storage of personal property of any kind and which is located for such purposes outside an enclosed building other than an accessory building or shed complying with all building codes and land use requirements. 217-14 Permitted temporary container. No such container shall be used outrue within the City of North Wildwood when in compliance with the standards of this article. It shall be the obligation of the owner and/or user of such temporary structure to secure it in a manner so as to not endanger the safety of persons or property in the vicinity of such temporary container. No such container shall be used within the City of North Wildwood when in compliance with the placement of said conting permit shall be \$40. be final. 217-19 Location. Portable storage containers are prohibited from being placed in streets, public rights-of-way or on unimproved surfaces in the front yard of properties. Placement may occur only upon driveways, side and rear yards if such locations meet the requirements of this section. All such locations must be paved, off-street surfaces at the farthest accessible point from the street. Placement of a container must comply with the side yard accessory structure setback requirements in the zone in which placement is to occur. If a property does point from the street. Wherever a portable storage container is placed, it shall be subject to all property maintenance standards applicable to accessory structures. No portable storage container shall remain in a state of disassembly or disrepair. 217-20 Violations and penalties. Any person(s) who is (are) found to be in violation of the provisions of this article shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$1,250. Each day that a violation continuer shall constitute a separate offense.
