NJ DIVISION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICES – CY2022 BEST PRACTICES INVENTORY QUESTIONNAIRE: City Clerk Jett stated that the City has provided sufficient correct responses on this State-wide questionnaire to maintain the highest level of State Aid available. The questionnaire this year has been modified and supplemented with additional questions regarding practices and procedures carried out by the City to ensure fiscal responsibility and compliance with State statutes. A total of 24 "YES" answers are required to maintain the highest level of State Aid; the City's responses contain a total of 32 "YES" responses. The CFO, City Administrator and City Clerk have reviewed the City's responses to the questionnaire.
